Cracow theme is a modified *Warsaw* theme.

Originally *Warsaw* theme uses “shadow” style and subsequently “shadow” uses a “split” style.

I modified the “split” style and *Warsaw* theme in the following manner:

- slide number and date are displayed in the footnote,
- there is less place for section titles in the header and more place for subsection titles,
- in the middle of footnote there is a place for an additional text, defined in the `\gdzie` command (*gdzie* means *where* in Polish). Here you can put e.g. a name of the institution where you give a seminar,
- small navigation icons are removed from slides. I’ve never seen anybody using them during presentation,
- smaller fonts are used in slide titles (frametitle).
